2.8 To provide training on proper healthful living using natural foods and remedies, through seminars and workshops every quarter or year.

2.9 To operate under the rules governing the formation and operation of societies/clubs of the Seventh day Adventist Church in world.

2.11 To encourage, exhort and otherwise spiritually nourish members and those of the Medical Missionary and Lifestyle Institute together with the Global Community.

2.12 To provide exchange programs for Medical Missionaries both locally, and internationally.

2.13 To organize workshops, seminars, Expos and research in various places and at various times in order to promote counsels on food and diet within and without the International Medical Missionaries centers.

2.14 To encourage and promote spiritual friendship, co-operation and understanding between or among the members of the MMM.

WHO ARE MEDICAL MISSIONARIES?

Every son and daughter of God is called to be a missionary; we are called to the service of God and our fellow men; and to fit us for this service should be the object of our education. Of all His children to the close of time, no less than of the first disciples, Christ said, *"As Thou hast sent Me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world"* (John 17:18), to be representatives of God, to reveal His Spirit, to manifest His character, to do His work.

True education includes the whole being. It teaches the right use of one's self. It enables us to make the best use of brain, bone, and muscle, of body, mind, and heart. The faculties of the mind, as the higher powers, are to rule the kingdom of the body. The natural appetites and passions are to be brought under

the control of the conscience and the spiritual affections. Christ stands at the head of humanity, and it is His purpose to lead us, in His service, into high and holy paths of purity. By the wondrous working of His grace, we are to be made complete in Him.

On every hand the world's enticements to self-seeking and self-indulgence call them away from the path cast up for the ransomed of the Lord. Whether their lives shall be a blessing or a curse depends upon the choice they make.

"God so loved, . . . that He gave," "gave His only-begotten Son," that we should not perish, but have everlasting life. "Christ . . . hath loved us, and hath given Himself for us." If we love we shall give. "Not to be ministered unto, but to minister" is the great lesson which we are to learn and to teach. John 3:16; Ephesians 5:2; Matthew 20:28.

Next to the angelic beings, the human family, formed in the image of God, are the noblest of His created works. God desires them to become all that He has made it possible for them to be, and to do their very best with the powers He has given them.

Life is mysterious and sacred. It is the manifestation of God Himself, the source of all life. Precious are its opportunities, and earnestly should they be improved. Once lost, they are gone forever. Before us God places eternity, with its solemn realities, and gives us a grasp on immortal, imperishable themes. MANUSCRIPT 31, 1901 We are to act our part, standing close by the side of Christ on his co-laborers. He is the head; we are his helping hand. He designs that we, by doing medical missionary work, shall undo the heavy burdens and let the oppressed go free. Let us not close our eyes to the misery around us, or our ears to the cries of distress which are continually ascending:

Christ's servants are to follow His example. As He went from place to place, He comforted the suffering and healed the sick. Then He placed before them the great truths in regard to His kingdom. This is the work of His followers. {COL 233.3}

The Lord wants every one of us to educate himself for God. At baptism, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost we were set apart to engage in the very work that Christ came to the world to do. What was He?—In the highest sense He was a missionary, and He was a healing missionary. {RH, January 7, 1902 par. 3}
